ACCESS INFORMATION

There is wheelchair access to most ground-level areas of the castle, but some loose gravel and uneven paths. If you need further information please ask a member of staff. Access limited to some areas.

Appropriate footwear is suggested for the walk around the castle and there are some very steep steps up to the walls and keep. The grass is allowed to grow tall in the grounds because it is a natural habitat for many rare plants.
