A Grand Medieval Day Out

Step back in time to Medieval Kenilworth Castle this Bank Holiday Weekend.

The year is 1214 and England simmers under the rule of King John, when Nicola de la Hay, royal sheriff, comes to inspect the castle and ensure the loyalty of the garrison. Will the arrival of her brother and her own family drama tip the balance of peaceful Kenilworth into civil war? Watch the unfolding drama and witness the harsh reality of medieval life and death in the 13th century.

Throughout the day, explore the bustling camp where you can meet tradespeople, the knights on campaign and the families supporting them. See traditional crafts in action including the blacksmith, woodworkers and weavers.

Seek advice from the herbalist for all your ailments or visit the cook's tent to see what it took to feed an army!

Listen to the sounds of the past with our medieval musicians Caliban's Dream.

The castle jester is also on hand to bring some laughter to the day!

- **11.30am The Gathering Storm** Sheriff Nicola de la Hey visits the castle to inspect the garrison on behalf of King John but could a family drama drag the peaceful castle into trouble?
- **12.00pm** Medieval Music Lively songs and dance tunes from the 13th and 14th centuries played on bagpipes, the hurdy gurdy and other instruments of the period
- **12.30pm** Medieval Fashion Find out why in the 13th century you are what you wear!
