## Whitby Abbey Gothic Falconry

**10:00** The Hawk House opens for visitors to view a beautiful collection of hawks, owls, and falcons at rest.

11:30 Gothic Flying Display – Discover the ancient symbolism and folklore of our feathered friends, investigate the source of popular avian myths and legends, and learn how our ancestors' viewed birds of the flesh!

1.30 Gothic Flying Display – Leave the dark ages behind and enter the age of scientific enlightenment as we reveal the discoveries made by C19th naturalists about birds from the theory of evolution right through to extinction. Learn how the Victorians dealt with birds of prey through experimentation, observation, and personal endeavour.

15:30 Gothic Flying Display – Delve into the dark side of nature as we explore man's relationship with raptors from ancient pagan times to the more contemporary Victorian age. Watch warriors of the sky in action and listen to a collection of period tales.
