There are countless interesting trees at Osborne. Some date from before the estate was bought by Queen Victoria, but many more were planted by the new royal owners and their guests.

Prince Albert planted many trees – some to make the landscape look beautiful, others as experiments to identify trees that would be good for timber. The royal family and important visitors also planted many trees themselves as a way to mark special occasions.



Whilst exploring Osborne look out for the 25 special trees which have been picked out and labelled. 12 of these have a green badge on their label which means they are part of this Family Tree Trail
