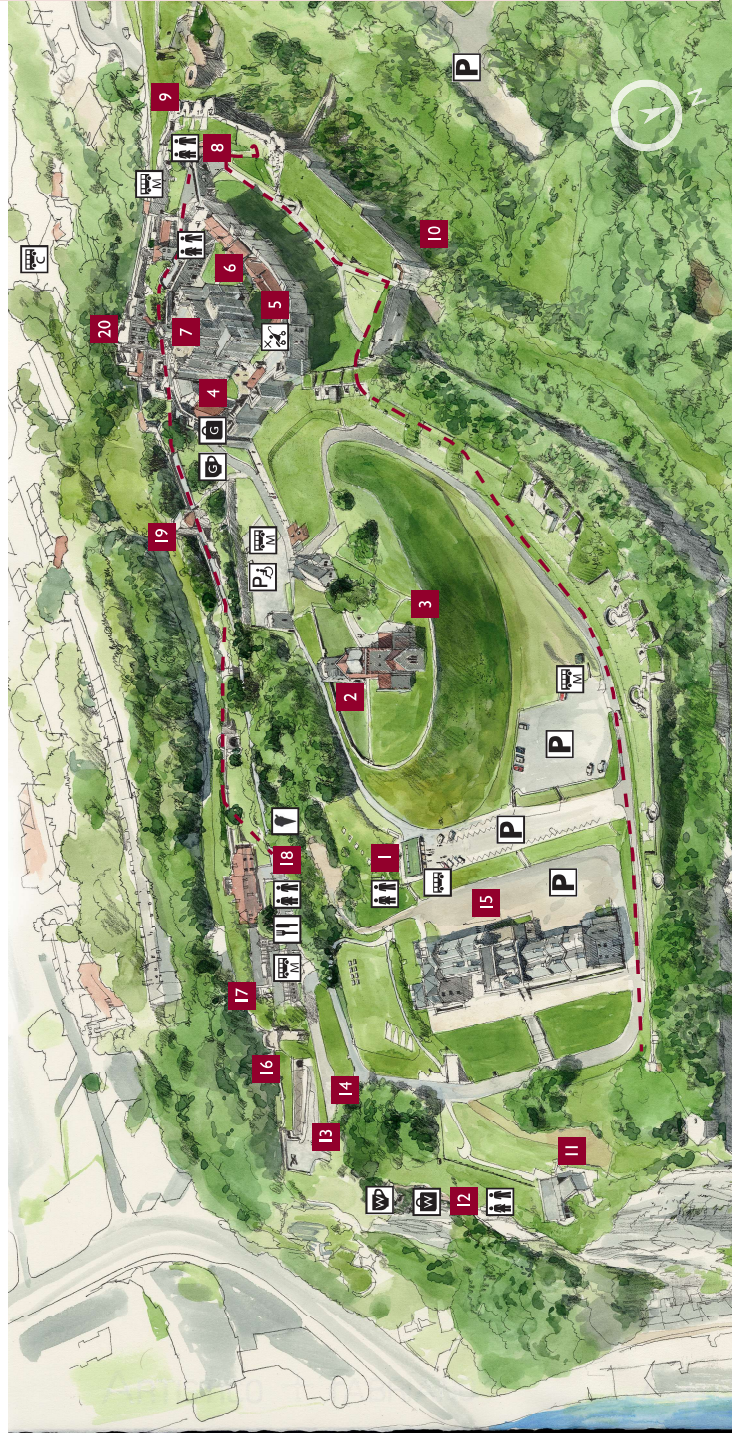
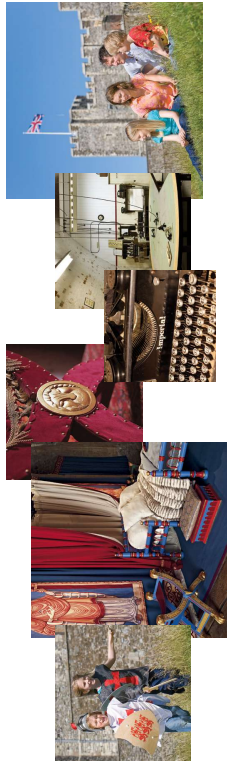


LOTS TO DO



ACCESS INFORMATION



Level access to shops, restaurant and cafés. Access to Secret Wartime Tunnels is via a steep slope with some uneven ground. The Great Tower's ground floor and the introductory exhibition in Arthur's Hall has some level access. Medieval tunnels, the upper floors of the Great Tower, and WWI Fire Command Post are accessed by steps and steep slopes and may be challenging. Mobility scooters are available on site and can be booked (subject to availability) although can be restricted in where they go due to their size. There is also a free mobility bus for those with additional mobility needs on a circular route, at approx. 15min intervals with four stops as shown on the map above. Induction loops are available in the main Ticket Office. Bottle/Food warming and highchairs are available in catering outlets on request.



Assistance dogs are welcome in all areas of the site. Dogs on leads are welcome across the site but must not be taken inside buildings. Dog bowls are provided outside the NAAFI Restaurant, the main Ticket Office, the Secret Wartime Tunnels shop, and the Great Tower Café.
