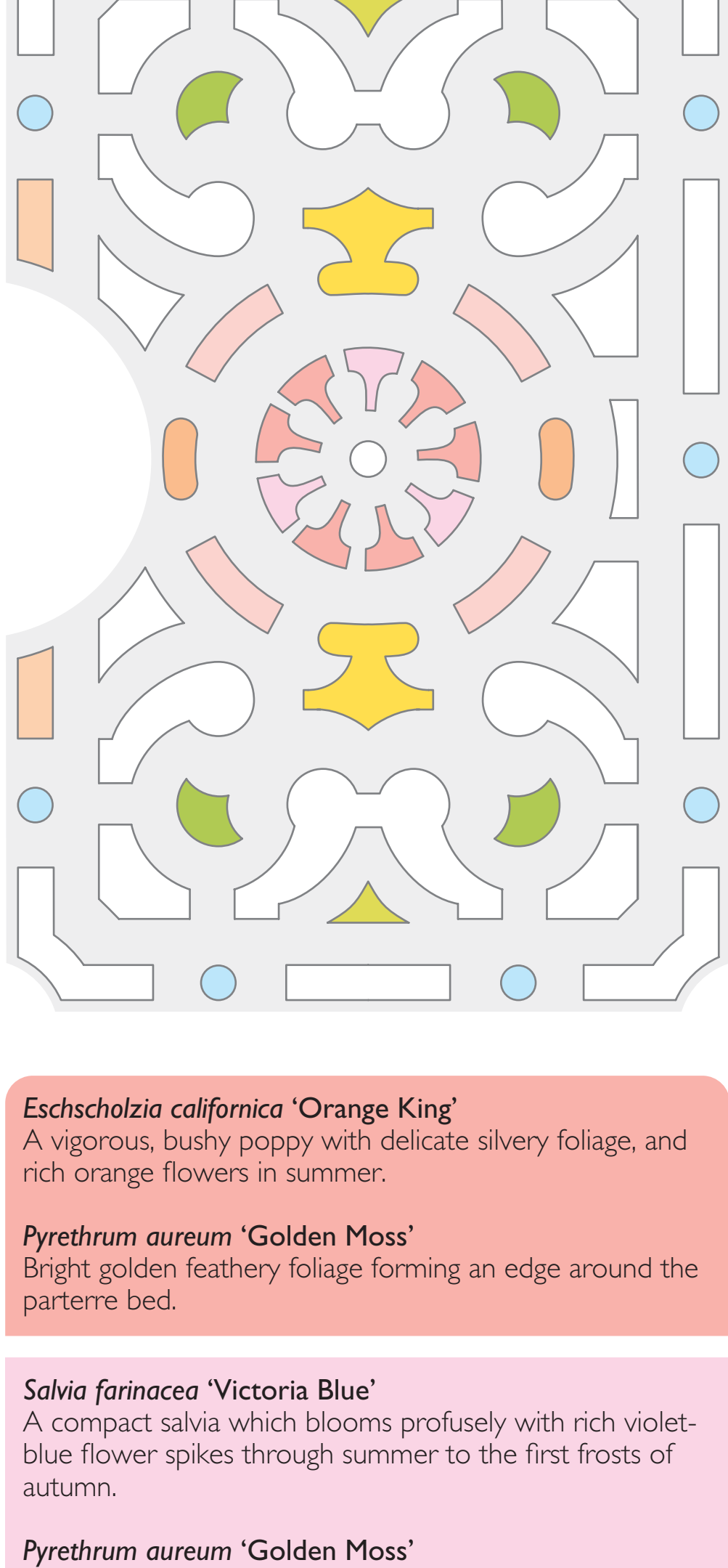


# AUDLEY END

## Summer planting



### *Eschscholzia californica* 'Orange King'

A vigorous, bushy poppy with delicate silvery foliage, and rich orange flowers in summer.

### *Pyrethrum aureum* 'Golden Moss'

Bright golden feathery foliage forming an edge around the parterre bed.

### *Salvia farinacea* 'Victoria Blue'

A compact salvia which blooms profusely with rich violet-blue flower spikes through summer to the first frosts of autumn.

### *Pyrethrum aureum* 'Golden Moss'

Bright golden feathery foliage forming an edge around the parterre bed.

### *Salvia coccinea* 'Summer Jewels Red'

A dwarf salvia that bears its long-lasting scarlet blooms above aromatic foliage through summer and into autumn.

### *Verbena rigida* 'Santos Purple'

A small, spreading, perennial verbena grown here as an annual, with oblong leaves and dense clusters of small, purple flowers from early summer into autumn.

### *Salvia patens*

A perennial salvia grown here as an annual for its two-lipped rich blue flowers from midsummer to mid-autumn.

### *Tagetes* 'Lemon Gem'

A marigold with finely-divided leaves and many single, lemon-yellow flower-heads through summer to autumn.

### *Pennisetum glaucum* 'Purple Majesty'

Grown for their linear leaves and feathery spikes, the stems and leaves turn from green to deep purple, while dark purple flower spikes are produced from July to September.

### *Tithonia rotundifolia* 'Fiesta del Sol'

A large, compact plant with green leaves that becomes covered with single, bright orange daisy-like flowers from July to October.

### *Dahlia* 'Rocco'

Lilac-purple ball-shaped flowers that sway on slender stems above green foliage are produced through summer until the first frosts.

### *Nicotiana glauca* 'Lime Green'

A short-lived tender perennial, with broad leaves and large, funnel-shaped, lime-green flowers which are most fragrant in the evening.

### *Petunia* 'Shock Wave Deep Purple'

A mounded, spreading annual which bear flowers ranging from a rich magenta-crimson to deep purple throughout summer until the first frosts.

### *Canna* 'Musifolia'

A tall-foliaged plant with large, long leaves flushed with bronze on the midribs and margins. Bears small orange flowers.

### *Pennisetum glaucum* 'Purple Majesty'

Grown for their linear leaves and feathery spikes, the stems and leaves turn from green to deep purple, while dark purple flower spikes are produced from July to September.

### *Dahlia* 'Rip City'

A wine-red flowered dahlia with a dark centre. The fully double flowers, produced from July until the first frosts, have a ruffled appearance with long, narrow, pointed petals.

### *Dahlia* 'Dark Spirit'

The dark burgundy double flower is made up of layers of silky, inwardly-curved petals creating a perfect sphere that bobs in the breeze on a tall, sturdy stem.

### *Dahlia* 'Bishop of Auckland'

With dark purple-green leaves, single red flowers with orange-yellow centres are borne from midsummer to early autumn on near-black stems.

### *Rudbeckia* 'Autumn Colours'

Above dark green leaves, daisy-like flowers with petals in shades of orange, red and yellow surround a prominent, conical, brown disk are produced in summer and early autumn.

### *Chlorophytum elatum* 'Variegatum'

More often seen as a house plant, it will happily grow outside in the summer. The variously striped green and white lance-shaped leaves provide another texture and contrast to the planting.

### *Salvia patens*

A perennial salvia grown here as an annual for its two-lipped rich blue flowers from midsummer to mid-autumn.

### *Tagetes* 'Lemon Gem'

A marigold with finely-divided leaves and many single, lemon-yellow flower-heads through summer to autumn.

### *Pyrethrum aureum* 'Golden Moss'

Bright golden feathery foliage forming an edge around the parterre bed.

### *Calendula officinalis* 'Indian Prince'

Bears orange daisy-like flowers, with tinted reddish-brown on the petals, through summer into autumn.

### *Salvia viridis* 'Blue Monday'

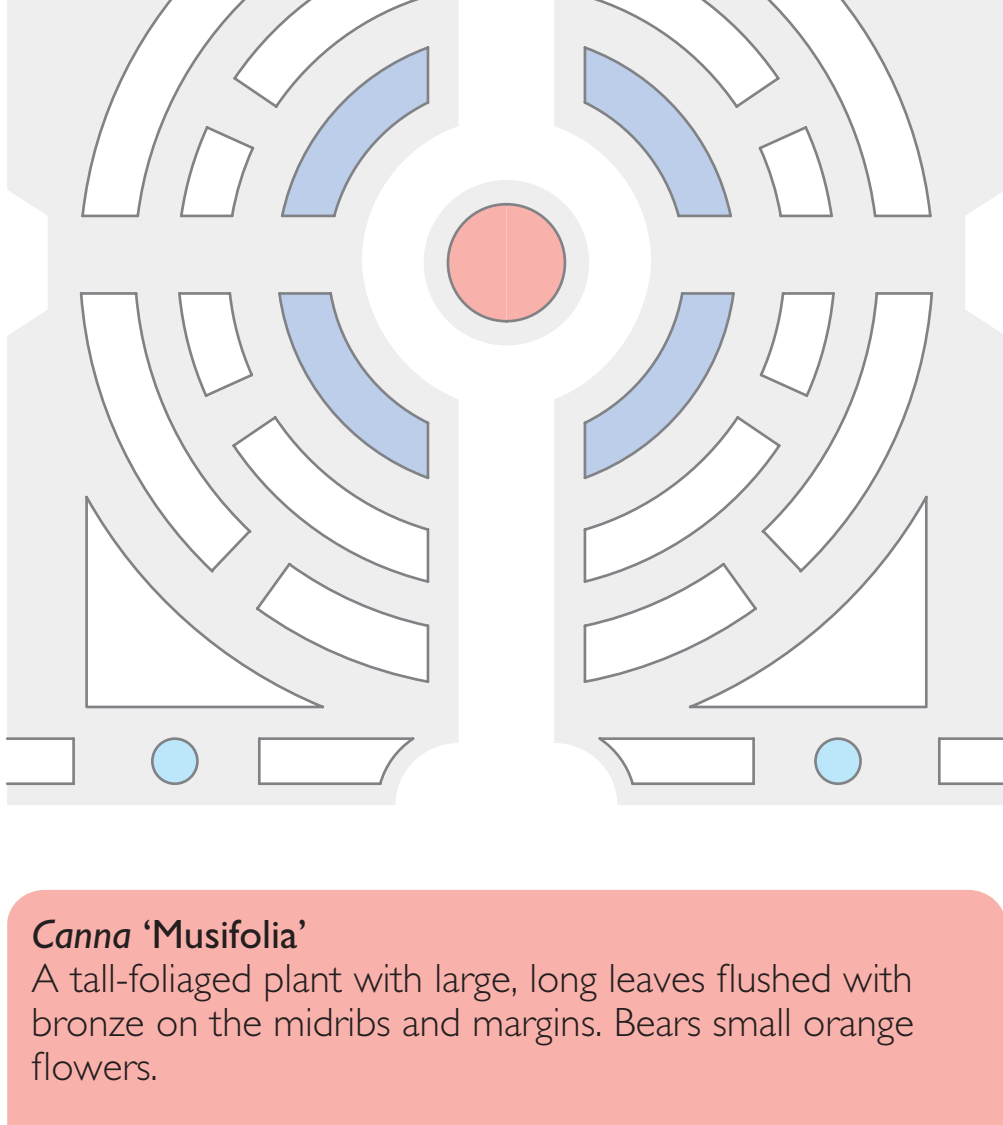
Grown for its violet-blue bracts, borne on upright stems from summer to autumn.

### *Verbena bonariensis*

Produces tightly packed clusters of bright lavender-purple flowers in late summer and autumn on top of tall, narrow, sparsely-leaved stems.

### *Verbena rigida* 'Santos Purple'

A small, spreading, perennial verbena grown here as an annual, with oblong leaves and dense clusters of small, purple flowers from early summer into autumn.



### *Canna* 'Musifolia'

A tall-foliaged plant with large, long leaves flushed with bronze on the midribs and margins. Bears small orange flowers.

### *Perilla frutescens* var. *crispa* 'Laciniata'

A bushy, aromatic annual, it has deep purple leaves with crisped and toothed margins. It also bears spikes of insignificant white flowers in summer.

### *Cosmos bipinnatus* 'Sonata Carmine'

A compact cosmos with finely-divided green leaves and, from summer into autumn, deep magenta flowers with a yellow centre.

### *Jacobaea maritima* 'Cirrus'

Grown as an annual around the bed edge for its silvery-grey felted leaves. Sometimes produces clusters of yellow daisy-like flowers in summer.

### *Verbena bonariensis*

Produces tightly-packed clusters of bright lavender-purple flowers in late summer and autumn on top of tall, narrow, sparsely-leaved stems.

### *Verbena rigida* 'Santos Purple'

A small, spreading, perennial verbena grown here as an annual, with oblong leaves and dense clusters of small, purple flowers from early summer into autumn.

### *Cordyline*

With sword-shaped leaves in dense clusters, when mature, it can produce large clusters of small, fragrant cream flowers in summer.

### *Osteospermum* 'Lavender shades'

Daisy-like flowers in a mix of azure, purple, lavender, mauve, and lilac hues, all surrounding a dark centre. This plant will flower through summer and into autumn.

### *Jacobaea maritima* 'Cirrus'

Grown as an annual around the bed edge for its silvery-grey felted leaves. Sometimes produces clusters of yellow daisy-like flowers in summer.
