Risk of infection spread due to introduction of facilitators into an 'education bubble'	Leaders, students, EH staff & EH volunteers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wherever possible workshops will be organised in an outdoor space. Where an indoor space is used, appropriate enhanced cleaning and hygiene measures will be in place to ensure any risk of infection transmission is minimised.</li> <li>Appropriate social distancing will be maintained between facilitators and the education group.</li> <li>Groups will be reminded that they should sanitise their hands immediately after the workshop has finished.</li> </ul>	2	2	4
Increased risk of transmission of infection via respiratory droplets	Leaders, students, EH staff & EH volunteers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All facilitators of workshops will maintain a 2m distance from the education group;</li> <li>Voice projection will be managed to avoid shouting.</li> <li>No singing or dancing will take place.</li> <li>Face coverings must be worn in any indoor space by adults and Year 7s and over</li> </ul>	2	2	4
Risk of infection spread through costumes or handling of objects	Leaders, students, EH staff & EH volunteers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Facilitators will either have their own allocated costumes or where costumes are 'shared' appropriate cleaning and quarantine procedures will be followed.</li> <li>Participants will not wear costumes provided by English Heritage during the current time.</li> <li>Facilitators will wear gloves or ensure objects used for demonstration/as part of the delivery are cleaned/ quarantined appropriately between each demonstration.</li> <li>Objects will only be handled by education group members where appropriate cleaning and quarantine regimes can be put in place between each individual handling the object.</li> </ul>	2	1	3
