
Filey Brigg to Scarborough Castle Yorkshire





Note: this map is intended as a guide only. We would always advise you to use these guides in conjunction with the OS maps referenced below. Please check the opening times of properties at www.english-heritage.org.uk before setting off.

Need to know

- OS reference: OS Explorer map 301
- Distance: 9.2 miles/14.8km (4 hours walking, plus time to look at the castle)
- Difficulty: 3/5
- Terrain: undulating coastal paths
- Opening times: Scarborough Castle I0am-6pm Monday-Sunday I April-30 September; I0am-5pm Monday-Sunday I October-3 November; Saturdays and Sundays only I0am-4pm 4 November-22 December; I0am-4pm 26-29 and 3 I December.
- Access: not suitable for pushchairs or wheelchairs
- Dog walkers: suitable for dog walkers
- Refreshments: cafés, pubs and restaurants in both Filey and Scarborough; coffee shop at Scarborough Castle
- **Grid reference:** starts at Filey Brigg (TA135814) and ends at Scarborough Castle (TA050891)
- Sat nav: starts at Filey Brigg, YO14 9HG and ends Scarborough Castle, YO11 1HY

Directions

- I From Filey Brigg, walk west onto the Cleveland Way. Continue along this path for around 8 miles, heading towards Scarborough.
- 2 As you approach Scarborough beach, continue onto Foreshore Road and walk for half a mile.
- 3 Turn left onto Eastborough Road, and then right onto West Sandgate.
- 4 Continue onto St Mary's St, and then onto Church Stairs Road.
- 5 Walk through the grounds of St Mary's Church, then turn right onto Castle Road. Walk for quarter of a mile, and Scarborough Castle will be ahead of you.
