## A GRIFFIN AT CARLISLE CASTLE

Inside a room in the keep are 15th-century carvings – one of these is of a griffin



## THE WILDMAN AT BELSAY HALL, CASTLE AND GARDENS

Find him on the crest above the castle's entrance and as a stone statue



## WYVERNS AT WREST PARK

There's a statue in the kitchen garden, plus various crests around the house. You can also find them in the decoration in the orangery, bowling green house and pavilion



## A CHINTHE ON THE CHINDIT MEMORIAL

See it on the Chindit Memorial on Victoria Embankment, Westminster, London



## THE GIANTS AT STOKESAY CASTLE

Complete the family trail to see if you can hunt down the lost key



## A DRAGON IN THE HERALDIC SHIELD AT ST MAWES CASTLE

Find it on the heraldic symbol above the castle's entrance



## SPHINXES AT CHISWICK HOUSE

You'll find a pair of them by the gates. Head inside to see another one in the Lower Link building



## PEGASUS AND A CHIMERA AT LULLINGSTONE ROMAN VILLA

See the creatures in one of the villa's mosaics, created from thousands of tiny stone tiles
