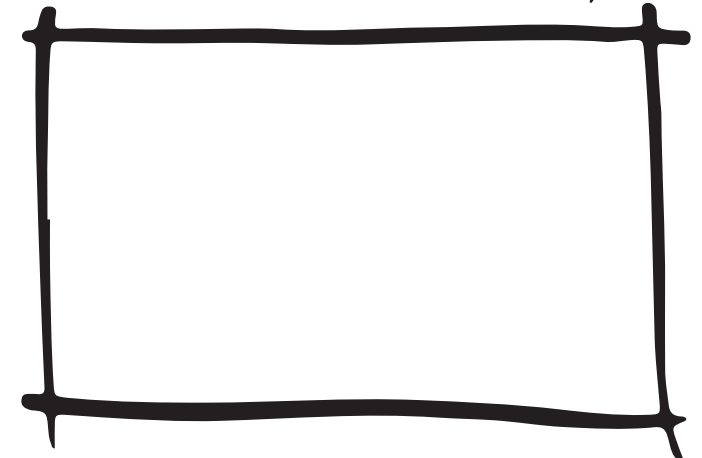

Draw an interesting leaf here. Can you identify which tree it came from?



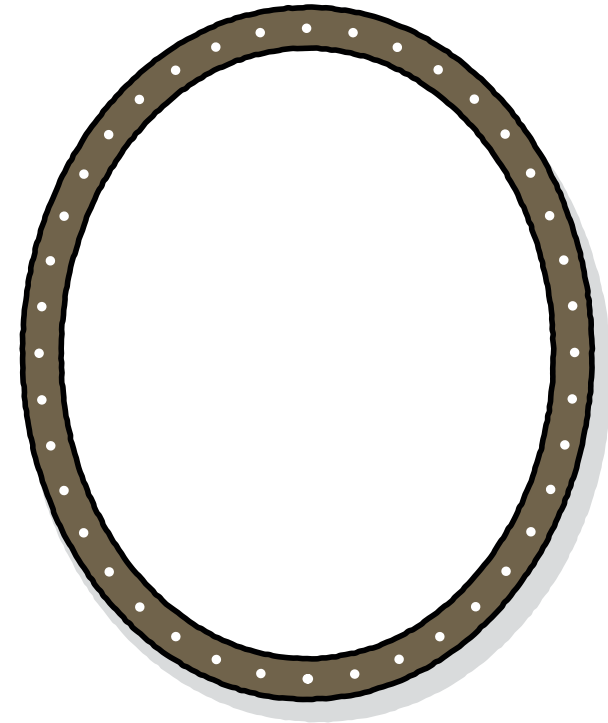
