SUMMARY A VERY GEORGIAN GARDEN: History and Landscape at Marble Hill

KSI–2 KS3

Learning objectives

WHAT: Understand how the Marble Hill landscape has changed over time; how the gardens were used by Henrietta Howard and the value of a range of source material in learning about the past.

HOW: Participate in an interactive expert-led tour of the gardens to examine key features of the historic landscape through hands-on activities.

OUTCOME: Communicate learning through a creative artwork session, exploring design and techniques using clay.

MARBLE HILL: HISTORY AND LANDSCAPE DISCOVERY VISIT

Explore the life of Henrietta Howard, a courageous woman from Georgian history. Marble Hill and Orleans House Gallery have partnered together to provide this excellent workshop. You will start in Marble Hill House, where through interactive and sensory activities you will explore the landscape and its rich history. After this a short stroll to our neighbours at Orleans House will see students will take part in an expert-led clay workshop using the landscape as inspiration. Please note: much of this Discovery Visit takes place outside so please check the weather forecast and make sure everyone dresses accordingly.

Please meet the facilitator at the Coach House. English Heritage Rangers will be there to collect your bags, so that you can explore the landscape luggage free. They will then return your luggage before you head over to Orleans House Gallery.

MARBLE HILL REVIVED

There is an exciting project underway at Marble Hill. We are working hard to open up the house more often, revive the landscape, and improve the facilities and develop our education provision made possible thanks to funding from the National Lottery and the support of lottery players.
